Further to your Freedom of Information Act request, please find the Trust's response(s) below:

1. *How many patients are registered with your Haemophilia Centre for*

- *Haemophilia A*
- *Haemophilia A – severe disease*
- *Haemophilia A – moderate disease*
- *Haemophilia A – mild disease*

Answer: The Trust has considered your request, however to provide you with the information requested would require the manual extraction and manipulation of information from various sources. To carry out this work would exceed the appropriate cost limit as set out in Section 12 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and is therefore exempt.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 Section 12 (1) and defined in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004, a public authority is not obliged to comply with a request for information if it estimates that the cost of complying would exceed the appropriate limit. The limit of £450 represents the estimated cost of one person spending two and a half days in determining whether the Trust holds the information, locating, retrieving and extracting that information.

2. *In the last three months, how many patients have been treated by your haemophilia centre for prophylaxis or for bleeding episodes with the following products?*

- *Factor VIII (any brand)*
- *Emicizumab*
- *Emicizumab in combination with any Factor VIII*

Answer: Not all Haemophilia treatments are stocked or supplied to patients by the Trust, therefore the Trust does not hold the information requested.
