It is also published on the website and should provide the public with an understanding of the information asset and how data is protected as a standalone statement.	<p>Currently, there are excessive outpatient appointments in routine cataract surgery caused by poor data flow between the community optometrists and the operating ophthalmologists. This results in all patients being referred requiring an outpatient assessment which is not needed in a majority of cases.</p> <p>EnVoi streamlines this process by allowing optometrists to complete more thorough assessments in the community so that routine patients who do not require outpatient assessments can go straight to surgery, saving the patient time and unnecessary hospital visits</p> <p>EnVoi is a mobile app that is downloaded by 3 user groups.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Patients are invited to download the app to complete the patient input data section of the referral. - Optometrists complete the referral on the mobile app - Ophthalmologists review the patient referral to decide if they are suitable to go straight to surgery or if they require an outpatient appointment first
