Please be aware that the Royal Devon University Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust (Royal Devon) has existed since 1st April 2022 following the integration of the Northern Devon Healthcare NHS Trust (known as Northern Services) and the Royal Devon and Exeter NHS Foundation Trust (known as Eastern Services).

- The number of FTE funded midwife posts there are for each maternity service at your trust? 73.59 WTE (whole time equivalent) Northern service. 127.6 WTE Eastern service
