   In the Eastern area of the Trust's all bank workers are paid as per agenda for change guidelines.

   Yes, Double time payments for allocation on arrival shifts

  How are payments distributed and authorised within the trust?
  Through weekly staffing hub through the Director of nursing for
  approval a week in advance and then through the daily staffing meetings
- b) Does the scheme/s have any eligibility criteria?.
   Not currently but under review.
- c) Is the scheme/s operational all year round or do you only offer incentivisation/reward at times of great need i.e. winter pressures?.
   This has been offered all year round where there are areas that are challenged and flagging red on our safe staffing SOP
- d) Is this a formal scheme or it is at the discretion of senior management to offer incentivisation as required?. ?
   It is a formal scheme managed and approved through the Director of nursing looking ahead at critical shifts and at then at discretion of on call teams dependant on acuity and safe staffing levels as per SOP
