The Trust's Attendance Management Policy gives opportunity to establish supportive conversations with colleagues with any health-related problems, seeking advice from Occupational Health and an individual's own specialist in relation to recommendations which could be advised and implemented in the workplace.

The Trust does have a Menopause Policy which sets out the guidelines for members of staff and managers on providing the right support to manage menopausal symptoms at work.

6) What are you doing to ensure staff have the knowledge and support they need with any issues related to their menstrual cycle?

This has not previously been an area of key focus. The Trust have focused current support and advice for staff on the topic of Women's Health on the menopause.
