Please be aware that the Royal Devon University Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust (Royal Devon) has existed since 1st April 2022 following the integration of the Northern Devon Healthcare NHS Trust (known as Northern Services) and the Royal Devon and Exeter NHS Foundation Trust (known as Eastern Services).

In 2022 you processed a FOI request asking how you treated conditions or probable or suspected conditions listed as i-iii) below?

- i. Pandas (Paediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorders Associated with Streptococcal Infections)
- ii. PANS (Paediatric Acute-onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome)
- iii. Immune mediated neuro behaviour conditions.

1) Tell me whether the Trust/ Hospitals treatment and diagnostic criteria has changed as a result of the working group statement.
