It is envisaged the Center delivers ophthalmology diagnostics services to patients across the South West - initially Torbay. Once patients had scans at the NHS Nightingale Exeter, images need to be transferred to Torbay for review, diagnostic and reporting by Torbay clinicians.</p>
