 I wanted to query the number of Maxillomandibular Advancement Surgeries that have been performed in the Trust for the first 6 months of 2022. The surgery is also known as double-jaw, mandibular osteotomy or bimaxillary advancement surgery.

Maxillomandibular advancement surgery is advancement of both jaws & almost always done for cases of obstructive sleep apnoea. This could be also known as bimaxillary advancement. The Trust can confirm that no cases of obstructive sleep apnoea and no cases of maxillomandibular advancement have been performed in the Trust.
