This small collection of documents is used to record care at home. A number of clinical and non-clinical personnel have access to these records to view, update and maintain a record of patient care. The majority of this care documentation will move to Epic. It has been agreed that a defined subset of data will remain in paper format to support patient care, where that care is given by agencies that will not have access to the electronic record in Epic. This DPIA sets out what information is used now in the home and how it will be managed in the future with the Epic implementation. The changes will provide greater protection of data in most circumstances.
