Issue and Return of Ballot Papers and Voting Information

Voting information will be issued by email to those members who have provided the Trust with a valid email address. Ballot papers will be issued by post to all other members in eligible constituencies. All members will be able to vote via the internet at www.mi-vote.com/secure, using the unique voter code contained in the email or printed on the ballot paper. Members who receive a postal voting pack will also have the option of voting by post. All votes, whether cast via the internet or by post, must be received by the Returning Officer by **5.00pm on Monday 16 September 2024**.
